We need your help!

Albury Conservation Company has recently funded a bold long-term plan to monitor Squirrel Gliders across Thurgoona. We are now seeking your help to purchase 25 wildlife cameras to kick-start the program. **Donations are fully tax deductible**.

Why Squirrel Gliders, and why Thurgoona?

The Squirrel Glider is a tree-dwelling marsupial that is threatened species in NSW with over 95% of its preferred habitat (Box Gum Woodland) lost. This remarkable gliding possum relies on tree hollows for shelter and trees spaced at 40m or less to move safely across the landscape. Thurgoona's roadsides, creeks and even urban backyards are home to a well recognised and important population of the species. However, Squirrel Gliders are under serious threat as Albury expands into prime habitat. If we don't monitor the population they are at risk of sliding into extinction before our eyes!

Albury Conservation Company is a leading local conservation group. We are not-for-profit organisation that has been advocating for the protection of local biodiversity for over a decade. We do this through driving research, building partnerships, and raising awareness and support in the community.

We need to purchase 25 camera units:

Motion sensing cameras are at the heart of our Squirrel Glider monitoring program. We need to purchase:

- 25 x motion sensing wildlife cameras;
- 25 x security boxes;

The cameras are 'Ltl Acorn Ltl-5310MC 44 IR LED Zero Glow HD Night Surveillance Hunt Trail Camera'. These cameras have been tested favorably in comparison to units 2-3 times more expensive.
